

NOTIFICATION OF SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEETINGS

As required by state law, the School Committee will give a minimum of 48 hours' advance notice (excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays) for any meetings of the Committee, including all subcommittee meetings. State law permits an exception in the case of an emergency, which the law defines as a "sudden, generally unexpected occurrence or set of circumstances demanding immediate action."

The School Committee will notify the public of the dates, times, and places of regular meetings by periodic publication of the meeting schedule for the ensuing months.

The Chairperson or designee will file notification of a change in a regular meeting time or place and notification of a special meeting with the Mansfield Town Clerk at least 48 hours in advance, as required by state law.
