

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION IN PRIVATE VEHICLES

School buses will be used for the transportation of students participating in co-curricular or extra-curricular activities. However, when buses are not available, private vehicles may be permitted to transport students to or from school activities that fall within the academic day or extend the school day provided all of the following conditions are met:

1. The activity has the approval of the Superintendent of Schools.
2. All drivers have completed the requirements of a C.O.R.I. check.
3. The parents/guardians of students to be transported in this manner will be fully informed as to this means of transportation and will sign a statement to this effect.
4. All rules and regulations pertaining to field trips, educational, sports, and other school activities should be strictly followed.

The Superintendent and building principals will develop practices and forms for the purpose of documenting approvals of student transportation in private vehicles.
